

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM
FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 BUDGETS
TOWN OF WATERTOWN
CONNECTICUT**

A referendum of electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meeting of the Town of Watertown will be held on Tuesday, June 16, 2009, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. to vote for the approval or disapproval of Fiscal Year 2009/2010 Budgets.

Voting will be at the following polling places:

Voting District 68-01 - Heminway Park School, Heminway Park Road, Watertown, CT

Voting District 68-02 – First Congregational Church, 40 DeForest Street, Watertown, CT

Voting District 68-03 - Swift Middle School, 250 Colonial Street, Oakville, CT

Voting District 68-04 - Polk School, Buckingham Street, Oakville, CT

The temporary voting location for the Voting District 68-02-Judson School shall be the First Congregational Church, CT due to construction activities.

Persons qualified to vote in Town Meeting who are not electors shall vote at the Office of the Registrar, 51 Depot Street, Depot Square Mall, Suite 113, Watertown, Connecticut.

Absentee ballots may be obtained at the Town Clerk's Office

The budget question will be placed on voting machines as follows:

1. SHALL THE FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 SCHOOL GENERAL FUND BUDGET BE APPROVED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,156,788?

2. SHALL THE FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 TOWN GENERAL BUDGET BE APPROVED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,810,584 AND SHALL THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 BUDGETS BE APPROVED IN THE AMOUNTS OF:
