**1. Call Meeting to Order**

Chairman Undercuffler, Called the Public Hearing to Order at 7:55 pm.

**2. Roll Call**

Mr. Murphy executed the Roll Call.

Chairman Undercuffler seated Ms. Russ for Mr. DiBona.

Chairman Undercuffler, read aloud the Ground Rules as follows for the record:

**Application #644 of Watertown Board of Education for restoration of a watercourse located at Watertown High School 324 French Street, Watertown, CT.**

Recess or adjourn the Public Hearing must be closed by October 16, 2008 unless applicant grants an extension of time.

Chairman Undercuffler, read aloud the legal notice.

Joe DiCarlo from Kaestle Boss Associates, Inc. was present on behalf of the applicant and explained the application to the Commission. Mr. DiCarlo advised the Commission that Michael Kline had flagged the wetlands on the site. Mr. DiCarlo explained that the wetlands were man made and on a steep slope. Mr. DiCarlo advised the Commission that the Town Engineer had recommended that this work be done during the improvement project. Mr. DiCarlo reviewed the concerns that the Town Engineer had and advised the Commission that all the concerns had been addressed. Mr. DiCarlo noted that it is the applicant's intent to create a stone rip rap swale. Mr. DiCarlo submitted into the record the revised plans. Mr. DiCarlo reviewed the revised plans with the Commission.

Mr. Rafey advised the applicant that all recommendations from the Town Engineer need to be on the plans submitted for review by the Commission. Mr. Rafey noted that if the plans were not complete that the applicant identify what had not been addressed on the plans.

Public – No one spoke for or against this application.

Mr. Rafey asked the applicant for the green cards.

Mr. DiCarlo stated that the applicant had sent them out. Mr. DiCarlo stated that he would have the applicant submit the green cards to the Land Use Office.


Mr. Orsini moved to close the public hearing at 8:07 pm. Mr. Polletta seconded the motion.
