Computer Monitors	Printers
Computer Hard Drives	Televisions
Mercury and Mercury Thermometers	Textiles (clothing, shoes, belts, cloth, etc.)

The Transfer Station takes the following items at NO CHARGE, and Residents MUST PURCHASE AN ANNUAL PERMIT:

Antifreeze	Glass Containers	Propane Tanks (1-30 lb.)
Alkaline Batteries/Car Batteries	Grass Clippings	Helium, Isobutane, Butane, Fuel Torches
